This is to prevent the spread of the pests into Susquehanna County. There is literature about these bugs available at the office. If you happen to find one of these bugs at your site, if you can capture it and bring it to the office it would be greatly appreciated. That way we can notify the USDA and get appropriate help in getting rid of them before they can have a major effect on the forests here.
